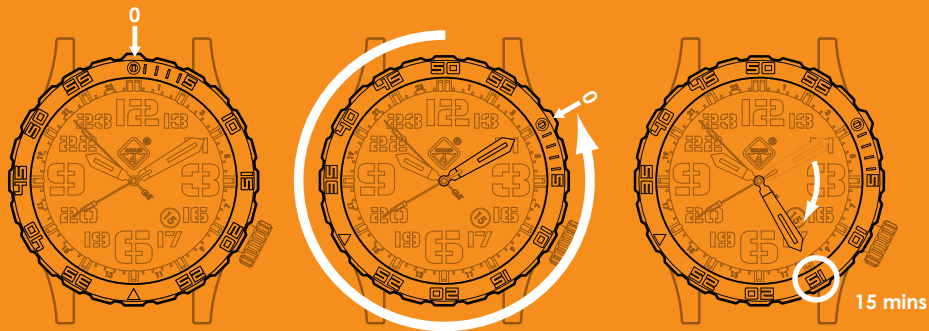

Using Dive Bezel

Use

If your watch has a dive bezel, it is a rotatable knurled 'wheel' around the watch crystal face with minute markings. These track time-at-depth, but are useful daily to time parking meters, etc. They are unidirectional so divers can only perceive a dive as longer if turned by accident.

Operation

Rotate the zero-point counterclockwise to the minute hand's current position. As the minute hand moves, read elapsed time on the bezel. If the minute hand passes the 0 point, add an hour. For long periods like airline flights, set the 0 point to the hour hand position, then time hours elapsed by treating the 5 min marks as hours.
